For such predation to be abolished a fundamental cultural shift must occur; the education of males combined with the strengthening of female autonomy must be at the forefront of this endeavor.

Girls Hope Rescue Mission

We work to address this issue by providing safe havens for girls affected by gender-based violence. Gladwell (our founder), rescues girls from abusive environments and provides them with the necessary tools to succeed, including access to education, health care services, and legal support.



Bright Spark Academy

Bright spark academy is a local elementary school in Kenya created by Girls Hope Rescue Mission. The school was opened inside the mission in January 2024 and is currently providing an education for hundreds of girls and boys. Elementary-age girls who live at the mission go to school there, but so do girls and boys from local villages.
