Girls Hope Rescue Mission (GHRM) is a nonprofit organization in Kenya dedicated to safeguarding and educating girls while positively impacting the local culture. In January 2024, BSA, an elementary school providing education to girls living at the mission and girls and boys from local villages, was opened. Additionally, plans to expand educational opportunities to grades 7 and 8 with the opening of a middle school in January 2025 are underway. They have secured funding for high-speed Internet and are planning a solar energy system for reliable electricity. Led by Gladwell Wachira, the founder of GHRM, the organization has helped over 100 girls currently housed in the mission and over 400 girls and boys currently attending BSA, with further expansion plans in progress. Their mission is to combat gender-based violence by rescuing girls, providing tools for success, and advocating for their empowerment globally. GHRM offers safe havens, education, healthcare, and legal support to girls affected by gender-based violence.



### Bright Spark Academy

Bright spark academy is the newest project of GRHM that strives to empower young girls who have been subjected to gender-based violence. The academy focuses on skill development and education for children so that they can reach their full potential. The new curriculum will include farming, vocational, and computer science training. The academy gives its students a well-rounded experience and provides basic needs such as housing and food so as to bridge disparities and prioritize education. The new campus is in the center of GHRM Permaculture design and is a space of security, safety, and learning, surrounded by the most successful agricultural property in Migori county. Their key goal is proper and principles based education for these children.

### Updates

GHRM is proud to announce innovative projects to further empower communities and foster positive change. With Starlink, high-speed internet can be accessible for remote and underserved communities, bridging the digital divide and giving GHRM resources such as online education, family and community connections, and telehealth services.

Additionally, As part of their vocational training of boys & men program, GHRM is proud to announce their solar installers team project. Many young men in Kenya suffer from substance abuse and may turn to a life of crime. GHRM is dedicated to preparing this next generation of men to be good husbands to promote cultural change by providing vocational training in installing solar panels.
