SURGICAL CENTER & VOCATIONAL TRAINING FACILITIES

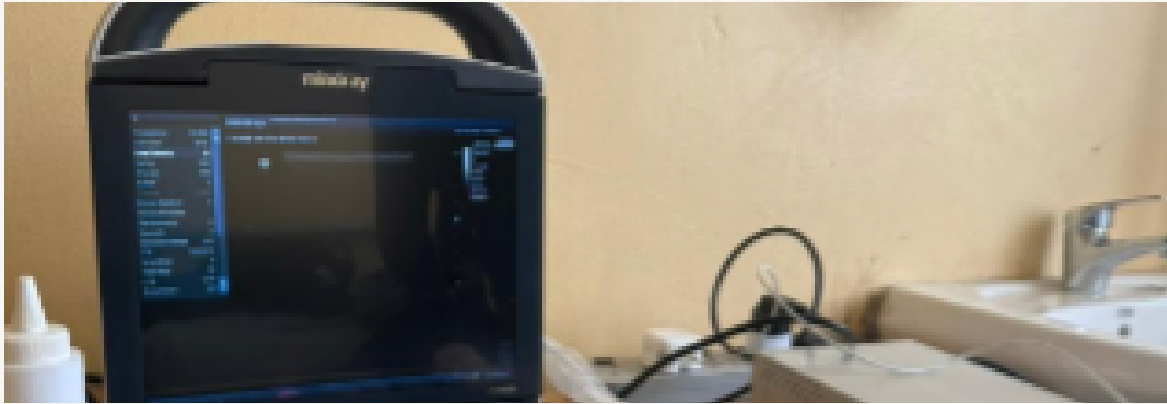
In April of this year, we welcomed the opening of our new Joseph Smith Hospital to serve and provide medical treatment to the girls at GHRM. After opening, we are further expanding the hospital to include a surgical center and surgical theater, which will help continue to provide healthcare to our girls. The surgical center features modern equipment and dedicated operating rooms, allowing the medical team to perform procedures that were previously unavailable in the area.



Along with the new surgical center of the hospital, construction has been ongoing with our vocational center. The center offers training programs in construction, brick making, and computer technology for both young men and women in the area, as well as tailoring. With over 500 students now attending Bright Spark Academy and the hospital treating patients daily, GHRM continues to transform lives in rural Kenya. The surgical center and vocational training facilities represent the next chapter in this mission, offering hope and opportunity where they are needed most.

UPDATES AND HIGHLIGHTS

JOSEPH SMITH HOSPITAL AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING



In our surgical center, we aim to help provide treatment to young girls who have suffered through FGM (female genital mutilation) and to help aid women and girls who need to receive C-sections during birth. The construction utilizes the same team that built our school and hospital is returning to work and is employing young women from our community. By utilizing community members, we have seen an improvement in the economic well-being of our village.

UPDATES

- Our Vocational Training Center is still a work in progress; however, it is moving along nicely, and the tailoring center is nearing completion. We have some new equipment, including brand new industrial sewing machines, knitting machines, and treadle machines. These will allow the women to be trained in making GHRM uniforms and clothes for the community.
- In the training center, equipment is being set up for students to learn to use a 40-station computer lab, which will help with online higher education and help provide training to our students.

Director Gladwell believes in the importance of providing opportunities for the girls at GHRM to learn trades and to provide young men opportunities to learn trades as this will help them stay away from drug and substance abuse. This will help better the community in Kenya and help provide stable job offerings.
